The Department of Math is pleased to continue the **Math Ninjas Project**, an initiative designed for students from Grade 1 to Grade 8. The project focuses on strengthening mathematical skills, nurturing logical thinking, and enhancing problem-solving abilities, empowering students with the confidence to excel in mathematics.

The project includes the following programs:

1. MATH MAGICIANS

GRADE	ACTIVITIES	ASSESSMENT
1 - 8	Students will refer Workbook 2 for the 'Math Magician' activity sheet which will be informed through the weekly plan.	Teachers will assess the students' activity sheet every week to strengthen their core concepts.

2. MATH TABULATORS (MULTIPLICATION TABLES)

GRADE	ACTIVITIES	ASSESSMENT
1 - 3	Students will be encouraged to write times tables in their math notebook. Teacher will spend 5 minutes recalling times tables through written or oral activities such as: ➤ Multiplication songs and rhymes ➤ Multiplication games and puzzles ➤ Multiplication drills ➤ Multiplication using technology Grade 1 – Table of 1, 2, 5, 10 Grade 2 – Table of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 Grade 3 – Tables from 2 to 10.	Weekly assessment is conducted to evaluate students' progress (every Tuesday).
4 - 8	Teacher will spend 5 minutes recalling times tables through written or oral exercises such as: ➤ Multiplication bingo and flash card race ➤ Multiplication drills ➤ Multiplication using technology Grade 4 to 8 – Tables from 2 to 12.	Weekly assessment is conducted to evaluate students' progress (every Tuesday).

3. MATH MASTERS

GRADE	ACTIVITIES	TIME PERIOD
1 - 8	Students will solve "Math Masters" questions in Workbook 2 , designed to strengthen problem-solving skills and enhance critical thinking.	Once a week

4. MATH MARVELS

GRADE	ACTIVITIES	TIME PERIOD
1 - 8	Students will be given a concept-related research based question through which they can explore ideas and display creativity.	Once a month
